1) Setup

- 1 4 players, each player gets a **Scorecard**
- One player draws cards, all place tiles at the same time

2) Placing Tiles

· Rotate any way you want, place faceup








• Tiles have to touch







. Higher levels: Cover 2 or more tiles, no overhangs








Scoring

- Multiply the number on the tile with the level they are on
- Use a copy of the **Scorecard** to add your points
